Auditor of State Mary Mosiman today released a report on the Iowa School for the Deaf, Council Bluffs, Iowa for the year ended June 30, 2014.

The School is governed by the Board of Regents, State of Iowa and provides an education commensurate with the needs of students who are Iowa residents and less than twenty-one years of age with hearing loss which is too severe to acquire an education in the public schools. The School also provides services for residents of the State of Nebraska upon such terms as may be fixed by the Board of Regents. For the year ended June 30, 2014, the average enrollment was 107 students with an average cost per student of \$95,795, compared to an average enrollment of 106 students and an average cost per student of \$94,498 for the prior year.
