Powerball Players Can Multiply Prizes Even More With Power Play 10X

In March, players who choose the Power Play with their Powerball ticket will have the chance to multiply their non-jackpot prize to up to \$2 million with the Power Play 10X promotion.

During the promotion period, one of the four "5"s on the Power Play wheel will be substituted with a "10." During this period, if the number 10 is drawn during a Power Play drawing, all Power Play prizes will be multiplied by 10 for eligible players who have purchased the Power Play option for an extra \$1 per play. That means, if you win the \$200,000 second tier prize with the Power Play on your ticket and the 10 comes up on the Power Play wheel, you'd win \$2 million! Jackpot prizes are not eligible for multiplication.

Promotion runs until 10x is drawn

Sales for the 10x promotion will start on March 2, and the first drawing with a 10 on the Power Play wheel will be Saturday, March 4. The promotion will run for at least eight drawings or until the 10 on the Power Play wheel is drawn at least once, whichever period is longer. The 10 could be drawn up to eight times



during the promotion (once for each of the eight draws). If the 10 is drawn at least once during the month of March 2006, then the 10x promotion will end with the final drawing on March 29. Multi-draw Powerball with the Power Play tickets purchased prior to March 2 that are good for drawings during the promotional period are eligible for the 10x promotion.

How the Power Play works . . .

The Power Play multiplier number is chosen by a wheel spin during the Powerball drawings on Wednesday and Saturday evenings. The Power Play costs an extra \$1 per play. Usually, the wheel has the numbers "2" through "5" listed on it. The Power Play number determines by how much a winner's prize will be multiplied. For example, if the number "5" is drawn, each prize, except the jackpot, will be multiplied by five. A \$200,000 prize would be worth \$1 million. receive a "VIP Connection" newsletter. This quarter the newsletter will contain a coupon for \$1 off a \$3 or more purchase of Pick 3, either with the number 297 or 298. Both are valid through March 31. These coupons will vary in appearance, depending on whether players receive their newsletter by mail or through e-mail. Coupon #297 comes from the color printed copy of the newsletter players receive by mail. Coupon #298 comes via the Internet. Both of these new coupons will look similar to the graphic above. Coupon #297 will be in color and about the size of a dollar bill (just a little shorter). Coupon #298 may be larger in size (up to a full sheet) and printed in color or in black and white. It may appear to be a copy — please accept it anyway! Coupons no longer have the words "No Copies Accepted" printed on them. If you have a question about a coupon, please call the nearest lottery office.

Don't Let Powerball and Hot Lotto Mistakes Get You Down

If you happen to make an error selling a Powerball or Hot Lotto play, it doesn't have to be the end of the world!

Let's review the steps you must take to handle a "mistake" Powerball or Hot Lotto ticket.

If the ticket did not print or the ticket is misprinted or mutilated so it can't be validated:

- —The defective play must be confirmed by immediately producing a REPRINT ticket.
- —Call the SGI hotline at 800-858-4744. They will provide you with a Control Number. They'll also help you get the information needed to report the problem to the lottery and, if necessary, help you produce the REPRINT ticket.
- —Any or all parts of the defective ticket, along with the REPRINT ticket and Control Number, must be returned to the lottery in the retailer settlement envelope.
- —When the lottery receives the defective ticket and the REPRINT ticket, we'll examine it and then issue credit to the retailer for the cost of the ticket. You can't receive credit if you don't follow the first three steps!

If the ticket is printed correctly by the terminal, but the clerk or the player makes an error:

- —Call the SGI hotline to report the problem and correct ticket information. A Control Number will be provided.
- —Remember, the ticket is still valid and can be sold. If you can't sell the ticket, validate it for any prizes won on the ticket after all draws have passed. Then send the ticket and the control number to the lottery in the retailer settlement envelope. The lottery will credit you for the cost of the ticket less any winnings.

The most common reasons for denying credit:

- 1) The retailer did not call SGI.
- 2) No ticket or play was sent to the lottery.

In short, if you don't follow the steps outlined above, you are out of luck!

Think about this: why not sell the ticket? Unless the problem ticket is a mutilated ticket, why not try to sell it to one of your other customers? Especially during busy, high-jackpot times, your customers may be more willing to take that ticket than stand in line.

Ankeny Man Wins \$10,000

An Ankeny man got the surprise of his life when he walked into a convenience store to pay for gas.

Richard Haes of Ankeny won \$10,000 in the Feb. 1 Power-

ball® drawing. He purchased the winning ticket at Quik Trip, 3700 Hubbell Ave. in Des Moines.

Haes said he had no idea he had won until a convenience store clerk checked his tickets.

"I had just filled up with gas, so I had [the clerk] check my tickets while I was paying," said Haes. The clerk told him the good news. "I said 'Oh my God.' I didn't believe it. This is the most I've won in Powerball," said Haes

Haes plans to put part of his winnings in savings and use the rest to buy his daughter something nice. He claimed his prize at the Iowa Lottery's headquarters in Des Moines.

If Haes had chosen to play the Power Play $^{\otimes}$, he would have won \$40,000.

Palo Woman Wins Third TV

Bobbie McLane of Palo, who won the third big screen in the drawing on Feb. 2, was accompanied by her husband Bruce when she drove to lottery head-quarters to pick up her prize.

"My husband went from work to check messages and called me and told me that I was the luckiest person he knew because I'd won a TV," McLane recalled. "I started telling everyone right away."

Bruce might have meant that just about one month earlier, she won \$30,000 playing the "Wild Crossword" (confetti) instant-scratch ticket. McLane said she felt lucky lately. And she had some advice for wannabe winners.

"You can't win if you don't play," she said.

Players enter the contest with a nonwinning "Winter Green" scratch ticket. Players go online to the lottery's Web site, www. ialottery.com, and enter the serial number of their nonwinning tickets for a chance to be drawn in one of the second-chance drawings.

One drawing remains on Feb. 23, 2006.

Des Moines Woman Gets \$100,000 Birthday Present

One Des Moines woman received an early birthday present playing the lottery.

Angela Huse, 31, of Des Moines won \$100,000 playing the "Winter Green" instant-scratch game. Her husband had purchased the winning ticket for her at Casey's, 3527 Indianola Ave. in Des Moines before coming home from work.

Huse said, "My husband and I buy [scratch tickets] all the time ... The most I ever won was \$500. I don't

know what to think. I still can't believe it."

Huse actually works as the assistant manager at the Casey's where her husband bought the ticket. Huse said the prize came at a good time, considering her 32nd birthday was only a few days away.

"Now I can buy a new car!" she said.

Huse says she may also spend some of her winnings on her family.
